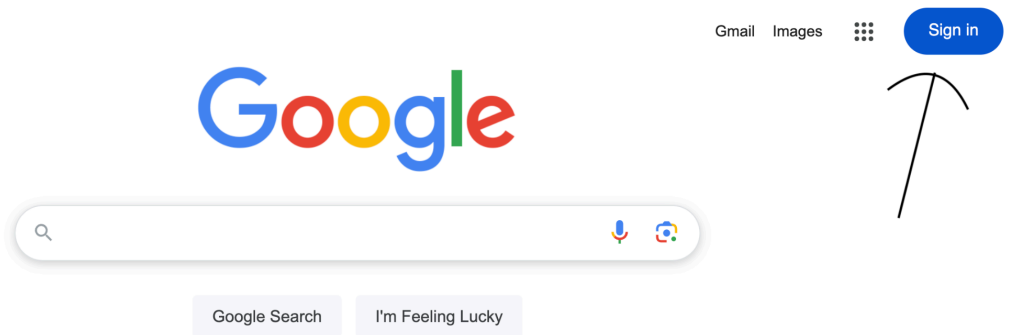
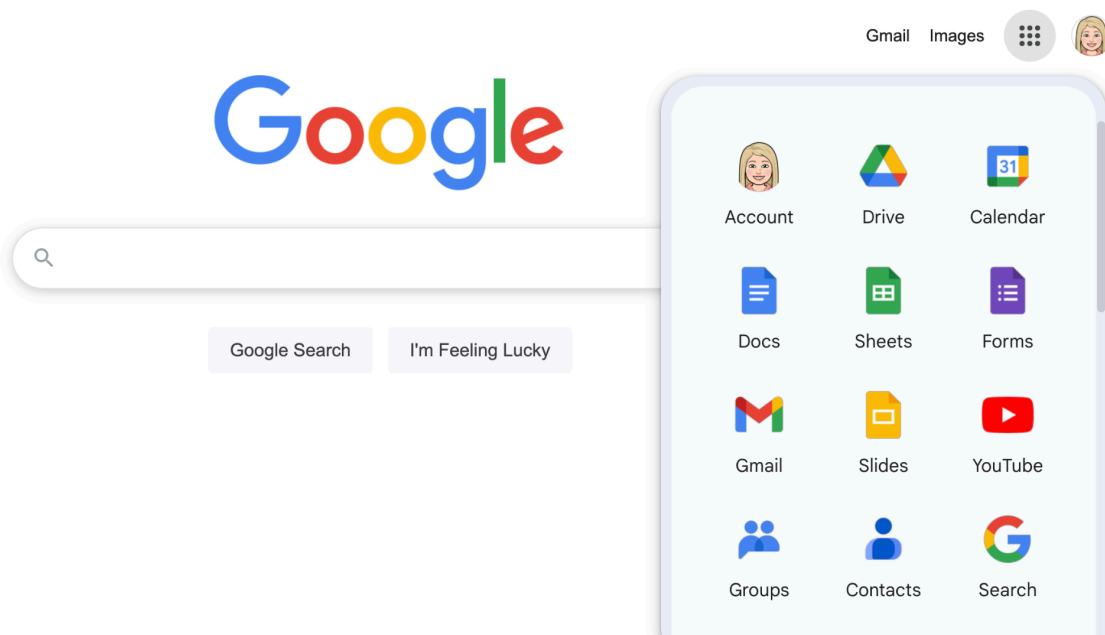


## How to Login to Any Computer at Home

1. The computer must have Chrome downloaded.
2. In the top right corner, click sign in and login with the email and password provided.



3. Once logged in, you will click on the waffle to access everything (scroll down for more options).
  - a. Google Drive - where everything done on their Chromebook is saved
  - b. Google Docs/Sheets/Slides - work on assignments
  - c. Canvas - access all assignments
  - d. Many other apps



4. If you do not see what you are looking for under the waffle, click on Canvas and look for links there.

## How to Login to Canvas

\*\*If you are on a home computer, you will need to do the items listed on the other page. If you are on a school computer, it should automatically open upon start up. If not, go to the waffle.\*\*

1. Click on 'Login with Canvas Student Login'.



2. Students may be asked for their email and password which is listed below.
3. You will be brought to the teacher's homepage. Here you can access the following things:
  - a. **Links on the middle graphic** - This will differ based on how the teacher uses Canvas, but click on the graphics to go to certain subjects, websites, or other information the teacher has provided.
  - b. **Left menu bar** - This will differ based on how the teacher uses Canvas, but could include announcements, modules, grades, etc.
  - c. **Right menu bar** - This will differ based on how the teacher uses Canvas, but could include a course calendar and items on your student's to do list.

\*\*\***Snow Day Assignments** - All assignments will be found in Canvas for snow days.
