Parking lot/pick up follow up:

The 2022-2023 Land Trust Measurement was 1 year growth

The current trend in Intervention Data is overall growth among the student body

Projected number of students is projected to add 35 students

Projected adding 1 teacher

Wellness room: calm down room, mostly utilized by school psychologist, sensory items, puzzles, blocks, quiet music to help reset to go back to class, can also be used for kids who socially and emotionally need a safe space to calm down

Budget \$61,000

Aids: 6 people, Remaining: wellness
