Final Report for Land Trust
For 2022-23

ELA Growth:

According to our school report card (schools.utah.gov) using RISE data, our students in grades 3-6 earned a HIGH ranking for growth in ELA (68.5%). The growth of our Lowest 25% also earned a HIGH ranking (75.4%), earning an overall school ranking of EXEMPLARY for student growth.

Acadience scores showed 82% of our kindergarten students left kindergarten on or above grade level in Reading, while grades 1-3 had 63% of students making typical or better growth.

Math Growth:

According to our school report card (schools.utah.gov) using RISE data, our students in grades 3-6 earned an AVERAGE ranking for growth in Math (61.8%). However, the growth of the Lowest 25% earned an overall HIGH ranking (just over 75%).

Extra Funding:

Thanks to PTA funding field trips and one-time school start-up funding, we were able to use about \$8,700 of Land Trust funds for chromebooks for student use in the classroom. Our goal is 1:1.
