Land Trust Final Report For 2023-2024

Goal: We will increase the number of students reading on or above grade level at the beginning of the school year by 3% at the end of the school year.

Reflection: Grades K-3: Acadience Benchmarks (reportcard.schools.utah.gov): We saw a 19.8% increase in the number of our students reading on or above grade level from 2023 to 2024, with just over 70% of our students making typical or better growth progress. That is a 7.5% increase from the year before.

Grades 3-6: RISE: We saw a 6.2% increase in student reading proficiency in grades 3-6, which grew from 46.7% to 52.9%. Our student growth stayed steady, earning us a ranking of being the second highest growth school in our district in ELA and an "Exemplary" ranking from reportcard.schools.utah.gov.

We attribute much of this growth to excellent Tier 1 instruction and Tier 2 and Tier 3 interventions, which includes Walk to Read.

Goal: We will increase the number of students on or above grade level in math at the beginning of the school year by 3% at the end of the school year.

Reflection: Grades K-3 Acadience Math: We saw a 6.9% increase of students on or above grade level in math in grades K-3. We grew from 54.6% proficiency to 61.5%, with 61.5% of our students making typical or better growth progress.

Grades 3-6 RISE: We saw a 5.2% increase in student proficiency in math, with a 14% increase in growth. We grew from 47.1% of students on or above grade level in math to 52.3%. This growth earned us the #1 spot in our district for student growth in math.

We attribute much of this growth to excellent Tier 1 instruction and Tier 2 and Tier 3 interventions, including our Math assistants.
