Reviewed 23-24 LAND Trust Goals

Goal #1: We will increase the number of students on or above grade level in reading at the beginning of the school year by 3% by the end of the school year.

Goal #2: We will increase the number of students on or above grade level in math at the beginning of the school year by 3% by the end of the school year.

Ronna reviewed data from last year. Math growth is typical, but ELA and Science growth are high. Our lowest 25% is very high. We earned an exemplary rating in overall growth, which is the best you can do. Our growth is great. Our mastery achievement will naturally follow the growth. Oak Leaf is mostly at level or higher than several other schools in the area.
