Safe Walking Routes:

Ronna: Every year safe walking route is revisited, it is due in January. We are in an area being developed that results in changes to the safety plan. Safety shuttles were allotted for 1 year.

Administration, teachers, safety committee, work with SCC, District Risk Management and Transportation Auxiliary Services, and Herriman City to determine the safe walking route.

Thyme: Currently all students south of Main are serviced by Safety Shuttles. In conversation with Herriman City, sidewalks will be installed on the sides of main which will change school bus eligibility and safety will change.

Prospected 2 crossing guards for 22-23 year.

Distance: 1.5 from middle of the road, to the closest measurement of the school property. Not based off of driving, but accessible pathways.

Safety is not based off of sidewalks, it is based off of the most accessible route

Map can be distributed, but is not concrete until Transportation with the District approves buses. This typically happens the 1st or 2nd week of July.

Ronna & Thyme will approach PD and City about safety in signs and directions surrounding school.

Standards-based Grading

Learning skills in data notebooks are very clear as to what the state standard is and the score means. This is based on how they are doing on the standard and not subjective. Assessments are done by grade level. This is based off of the state standard, then a learning scale is created based off of that standard. Measured against a standard to the end of the year. It is normal for kids to start lower in scale.

Rise results won't be back until May. Discussed using Acadience to determine growth for Land Trust distribution.

Parking Lot Lines/Before School Activities

Discussion regarding making parent lot to one direction.

Discussion regarding pick up safety issues that will continue to be monitored and addressed. Ronna and Thyme will follow up on concerns.
